We will be contacting patients whose surgery or appointment has to be deferred. Unless contacted, people should continue to attend their pre-booked appointments.

We are working on our contingency plans, and this will involve having Life Preserving Services available for those who need them.

Our emergency departments will remain open throughout the strikes, and all inpatients will continue to receive care.

There may be some delays due to reduced staffing, but safe care will still be available.

We respect the right of our staff to take industrial action.

Thank you for continuing to provide excellent care for people in our community.

We appreciate your patience on the days of these industrial action as our focus will be on supporting those who need our services during the strike period.
