Intended Purpose

A diabetes annual review (DAR) with the Primary Care Team aims to support patients with ongoing education, monitoring of their diabetes and early detection of diabetes complications. This programme is available for practice teams to provide their enrolled patients who have a diagnosis of diabetes with a funded DAR.

Eligibility/Inclusions/Presenting Concerns

- All patients with diabetes: Type 1 or Type 2

Exclusions

- Patients with pre diabetes
- Patients who have had a DAR less than 11 months ago

Key Information

- Māori and Pasifika patients experience a higher prevalence of diabetes, and experience higher rates of complications from their diabetes, than non-Māori and non-Pacific people.
- The difference in DAR funding is to promote DAR completion for Māori and Pasifika patients and reduce these current inequities.
